HOW TO COMPLETE THE CODICIL

- Print out the codicil – it must be available in hardcopy, and must also be an original.
- Make sure the codicil has been signed the same way as your original Will.
- Your codicil must be dated so the court is aware the document was made after your Will.
- If you'd like to leave a specific amount of money, then you should complete Option 1, and delete Option 2. Make sure that you sign next to the deletion.
- If you'd prefer to leave a certain percentage of the value of your estate, then you should complete Option 2, and delete Option 1. Make sure that you sign next to the deletion.
- Have your codicil signed by two witnesses. They should both be over the age of 14, and neither of them should be named in your Will. All three of you should sign in front of each other.
- Store the original codicil in a safe place, it should be kept with but not attached to the original Will it changes. This ensures the codicil is not overlooked.
